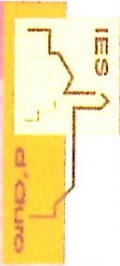

If we want to create a better world, we think we need to settle the basis for a good understanding :



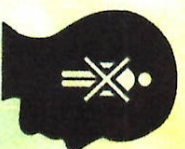
Diversity

Everybody has different characteristics, both physically and mentally. We are all different. Moreover, everyone has different opinions and believes.
